Scrubbing before your Open Heart Surgery/Carotid Endarterectomy

To prepare for your surgery, your surgeon asks that you clean your skin with a special antibacterial soap. This will reduce the amount of bacteria on your skin before the surgery, reducing the risk of infection in your incision after surgery.

How to do		
 One soap packet should be enough for each scrub. This may be done standing at the sink or in the shower. Use soft side of sponge. You do not need to add water; use directly from the package. Gently wash the areas that are marked above in slow, circular motions for several minutes. Thoroughly rinse off all soap with clean water. Towel dry. Dress as usual.
